## **ADDITIONAL NOTES:**

- Only Toronto Kart Club members in good standing will receive points, during regular TKC Points Events, in accordance with final finishing position with respect to other TKC drivers.
- 5 Bonus Points will be awarded to the fast qualifier in each class. The fast qualifier will be the driver with the fastest time in the timed qualifying session. In the event that two qualifying heats and a final heat are used, the driver earning the pole for the final heat shall receive the fast qualifier points. In the event that a non-member is the fast qualifier, no bonus points shall be awarded.
- A Black Flag issued during a qualifying session or heat race will cause the offender to start at the rear of the grid for the next session. Further penalties may be assessed. A Black Flag issued during a final heat will cause the loss of points for that event. That event may not be used as a drop. Further penalties may be assessed. A driver who is disqualified during post-race technical inspection will lose all points for that event, and may not use that event as a drop.
- A black flag with orange disk issued during a final heat (for technical on-track safety infraction) will require the driver to exit the track immediately. The driver will receive points coinciding with the position in which he/she finished.
- A driver who receives a DNS (did not start, failed to take green flag) during a final heat, will receive 0 points for that event.
- During the last 3 Points Events of the season: Any driver who moves into a new class, or any visiting driver, or any TKC driver who has not participated in at least 3 of the preceding 6 points events, must start at the back for all race heats, regardless of the qualifying position earned.
- In classes with more than 8 competitors, Event awards will be given to the top five (5) finishers.
- In classes with 8 or fewer competitors, Event awards will be given to the top three (3) finishers.
- Racing suits are to be worn by all drivers receiving an award, during the awards presentations.
- A driver's best 11 of 13 finishes (2 drops) will count towards final Season Points Standings.
- In the event of a tie in the year-end points total, the class champion will be the driver with the highest number of 1<sup>st</sup> place finishes throughout the year. If the number of 1<sup>st</sup> place finishes is also tied, the winner will be the driver with the highest number of 2<sup>nd</sup> place finishes, etc.
- All drivers who compete in a minimum of 10 Club points events will receive a year-end award, to be presented at the Awards Banquet. Additional premiums may be awarded to class champions and other top finishers. Actual awards and premiums may vary from year to year, and shall be determined by the Board of Directors.
- TKC reserves the right to designate any class as a "demonstration only" class, if three (3) or fewer competitors are entered in any event. Competitors in demonstration classes will not earn points, and will not receive awards.
