Subaru Karting would like to extend their invitation to all members of the karting community, the public and anyone that would like to see this exciting new program. All parents and children are welcome to come and see the show-karts modeled after the Subaru Rally cars, try on a racing suit, a race helmet and sit in the karts or just start your dream.

This is a beginner program and prior experience is not required. We can assist in finding suitable equipment both on the used and new market, driver training and guidance through the TKC executive.
